Mark 16:17-18 And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name ... they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well."

These were among the very last words Jesus spoke to His disciples before He ascended to the Father. This month on the 27th at 7:30pm we are starting our new Healing Service called "A New Service Of Praise, Healing And Prayer." In this service we will be offering the ministry of Prayer for Healing. Our team of prayer Ministers led by Revd Ian Evans and myself, will offer prayer ministry for healing and / or other matters that weigh heavily on our souls.

I believe that the ministry of healing is the gift of God through His church. When Jesus walked on earth, a major portion of His ministry was healing. People came believing "...and people brought to him all who were ill with various diseases, those suffering severe pain, the demon-possessed, those having seizures, and the paralyzed; and he healed them." Matthew 4:24 He promised His disciples "Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father." John 14:12.

Since last year I have felt the stirrings of the Spirit in my heart to begin to encourage the church to operate in the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Having received from the churches in the parish the ministry of prayer for healing myself last year, I began to feel God was that calling us to start this new ministry. Praying and consulting together with the other clergy and ministers in the parish, we are taking this step of faith. Will you please pray for the team that will be ministering at this service. Pray that we will remain humble and righteous before the Lord. Pray that we will allow the Holy Spirit to move among us and that we would be the channels of His healing.

This is a parish ministry and the team is made up of members from all three churches in the parish. Pray for the unity of the team, and the love of God to flow through us in healing.
