Every day we surrender our lives to people we do not even know. We rely on the doctor or nurse to have the necessary training as they treat us. We get into a bus trusting the driver to know how to drive us safely to our destination. Stuck behind a slow moving bus or truck on a narrow road in the mountains of Northern Pakistan, I'd often get waved on to overtake them. Just by waving me on a complete stranger was taking complete responsibility for my physical safety. I was putting my blind faith in someone who I did not know at all.

It is hard for us to surrender our own will and control, to trust our lives without reservation to God's care. Yet the reality of this is that this decision determines the outcome of our lives. We put the faith we profess into action when me simply take God at His word. In the 12 steps to recovery, the 3rd step is to "Make a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God as we understand Him." Paul assures us in Romans 10:9 that 'If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.'

Turning our lives over to God seems too simple but it is the hardest decision to make. Turning over the control of our lives to the Lordship of Jesus brings us into a place of great freedom, a place where we experience the love and provision of God for us, in so many ways every day of our lives on this earth and on into eternity. God calls you and me to trust Him with our lives.
