In the gospels we are told that there were three times, when Jesus called the trio of Peter, James and John to come away from the others for a reason. And each time an event of great significance takes place.

The first time, He called them to come with Him when he goes to Jairus' house to heal his daughter, a healing which eventually became a raising form the dead. This invitation enabled Peter and James and John to see the power of Jesus to perform miracles.

The second time, he called them to come up to the top of a mountain, where they saw Him glorified and transfigured talking to Moses and Elijah. This invitation was to a revelation of who Jesus is. As soon as Peter opened his mouth and ruined the moment a cloud covered the scene and the voice of God came from the cloud saying, "This is my beloved Son, listen to Him."

The third time Jesus called them out was when He left the upper room after the Last Supper to go to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray. They went to sleep there, and missed the battle raging in Jesus' mind and soul as He faced the cross. "Nevertheless not my will but yours." He said. It was an invitation into a very intimate moment with Jesus. IF they had stayed awake they would have seen the battle to submit to the will of God. They would have seen that after Adam and eve had lost this battle for obedience in Eden, and Jesus had won victory in it in the wilderness, He once again wins out, by submitting His will to the Father's.

What invitation has Jesus given you? And are you going to accept it and see the revelation.
