Together on the Road

In today's Lectionary reading, John 21:1-12 Jesus showed himself one again to the disciples, this time by the Sea of Galilee. Some of the disciples went out in a boat to fish but caught nothing. Jesus called to them from the shore and directed where they should fish and there were so many fish that day that it was difficult to haul it all in.

As soon as they came ashore, they saw that there was some bread and a charcoal fire with fish cooking on it. Jesus had met with these fishermen coming home from work and cooked their breakfast, and they recognised him — an ordinary everyday situation changed by an encounter with the Risen Lord. At the heart of our faith is the truth that God speaks to us in the ordinary events and situations of our lives, if only we take the time to stop and listen.

Pope Francis writes in 'The Joy of the Gospel' everyone needs to be touched by the comfort and attraction of God's saving love, which is mysteriously at work in each person above and beyond their faults and failings.

Where in our everyday lives do we recognise God's presence and experience love, truth, goodness, hope and joy?

Let's Pray:

Risen Jesus, just as you met the first disciples beside the Sea of Galilee, meet us on the shore of our lives. Help us to see you in the encounters we have each day and enable us to draw strength from your presence. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
