Easter Reflection

We love to read Psalm 23, we say it prayerfully in times of sorrow; recite its comforting words in periods of uncertainty; rehearse the assurance it offers for times of trial; and claim its promises as the very structural support of our faith and life. But maybe its words and thoughts can also guide us in a moment of confession.

"The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want." With these words I am saying that God provides me with everything I need, but do I really believe that?

"He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside still waters; he restores my soul." If God is restoring my soul, why do I feel so tired, so exhausted, so run down so overwhelmed?

"He leads me in right paths for his name's sake." Am I really living my life on the right path in every aspect of my life? Would I be comfortable and even proud to have God along with me everywhere I go?

"Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no evil; for you are with me; your rod and your staff -- they comfort me." Then why am I always looking elsewhere for comfort and protection? Why do I have so many fears?

"You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows." I wonder what my life would look like if I really did trust God. I wonder how I would view others, including my enemies, if I really believed God to be beside me.

"Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD my whole life long." Am I confident that God goes with me? Am I confident that I will live with God forever?

Know that God is with us now, forgiving us, rejoicing to be in our presence and willing to transform us by the power of the Holy Spirit into true and full disciples of the Son, Jesus, the Crucified and Resurrected Lord.
